SUBJECT: Los Angeles AFB (LAAFB) Statement of Environmental Commitment

1. The 61st Air Base Group is committed to providing best-in-class facilities, services and security for LAAFB, enabling the delivery of resilient, affordable space capabilities for the nation. To that end, this Statement of Environmental Commitment clarifies our unwavering pledge to mission sustainment through excellence in environmental stewardship and the protection of human health. It also extends requirements to comply with environmental regulations and integrate sound environmental practices into daily decisions.

2. In support of this commitment, every member of LAAFB will maintain an effective Environmental Management System (EMS) by:

a. Promoting the use of sustainable technologies and practices, responding to demands to continually improve environmental performance and minimizing adverse impacts to installation personnel, residents, the local community and the environment.

b. Encouraging the responsible use of energy and water throughout the installation, including the adoption of innovative practices to conserve and improve energy and water efficiency.

c. Complying with applicable federal, state, and local laws, and aggressively correcting areas of non-compliance.

d. Preventing pollution by using environmentally friendly and recycled materials to the maximum extent practicable, diverting solid wastes, minimizing the use of hazardous materials and reducing air and water pollution.

3. This memorandum supersedes previous guidance, same subject, and will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
