SUBJECT: Renewal of Public Health Emergency

1. On 26 March 2020, I declared a public health emergency (PHE) IAW AFI 10-2519, *Public Health Emergencies and Incidents of Public Health Concern*. On 24 April 2020, I renewed the declaration for 30 days. The situation involving Coronavirus (COVID-19) is ongoing. Therefore, IAW AFI 10-2519 and the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs' Extension of Department of Defense Public Health Emergency Declarations memorandum, dated 27 April 2020, I am renewing the PHE. This declaration will terminate automatically 90 days from the date of this memorandum unless it is renewed and re-reported, or terminated sooner by myself or a senior commander in the chain of command.
2. All instructions in my 26 March 2020 PHE declaration memo remain in effect.
3. Any person who refuses to obey or otherwise violates an order during this declared public health emergency will be detained. Those not subject to military law will be detained until civil authorities can respond. Violators of procedures, protocols, provisions, and/or orders issued in conjunction with this public health emergency may be charged with a crime under the Uniform Code of Military Justice and/or under United States Code, Section 271. Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 271, violators are subject to a fine up to \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
